### **How to Enter**

- **Entrants must be a member of the Sparta Camera Club.**

- We will accept up to 3 entries per artist.
- All entries must be submitted in digital jpeg format. Each image must be 72 dpi. The entry should be no longer than 1,280 pixels on the longest size.

- The entry must show the name of entrant and the title.  
.Smith\_Joe\_Title.
- We will be asking for short photographer's bios .
- We will notify you of your acceptance by email. When the email is received let us know the size of the framed work

### **Rules**

- The photos must be of some aspect of the Van Kirk Homestead including the grounds.
- Works selected must be delivered, ready to hang at the Sparta Historical Society on June 19.
- The works cannot be wider than 20 inches.
- All works must be picked up at the Sparta Historical Society by August 28.

- The Sparta Historical Society will exercise reasonable care with each piece submitted but will not assume any responsibility of liability relating to loss of or damage of works.
- The artist will be notified in the event that a work is damaged.

### **Important Dates**

Exhibit Dates: July 9– August 27, 2017

Digital Submissions May 8– June 5, 2017

Framed Entries must be received by Monday, June 19, 2017 from 10-12 am, or 6-9 pm

Works may be picked up between 4:00 and 5:00 pm on August 28th.

### **Gallery Policies**

- Works must be labeled in back with artists name, title, physical address, email, and phone number and price.
- All entries must be original to the artist.
- Artists are encouraged but not required to offer their work for sale at the exhibit.
- The Sparta Historical Society retains a sale commission of 20% on all sales.
- All work must be the property of the entrant: entrant must be the copyright owner and the work must not infringe on the rights of others.
- Works must remain on the gallery wall for the duration of the show.
- We encourage selected artists to offer additional smaller matted works for sales.
