#### **Entries**

Enter up to 5 images (color or monochrome in any combination.) Attach a completed entry form (page 3) and an envelope with the full amount of your entry fee (\$5 for each photograph entered; \$3 for students) to the back of the first print.

#### All Entries Must Be

- Matted with a 16x20 mat (except students) and have a backing board in place. Image sizes must be larger than 7 inches and should not exceed 14 x 18 inches.
   Student entries should have an 11x14 inch mat.
- Photos taken by the entrant, but may be printed by another individual.
- In good taste and consistent with the club's family friendly environment.
- Delivered to one of the drop off locations no later than noon (See Drop Off Locations).
- Not be wrapped in cellophane or plastic of any kind.
- Not have markings on the image or the front of the mat that could identify the artist.
- Each entry must be entered in one of the categories listed in Table 1 on Page 2.

## **Judging**

Three prominent photographers will judge the images at Sparta Camera Club on November 2nd, 2022 at 7 PM at the Sparta Ambulance Building, 14 Sparta Avenue, Sparta, NJ 07871. Junior/Student: (individuals under 18)	JR
<b>Beginner:</b> Individuals who are over 18 and are ranked as a Beginner in Sparta Camera Club (SCC). If you are not a member of SCC, you must be a novice photographer who is just starting to learn photography. Note: if you qualify as a Beginner, but have entered and won a ribbon (First, Second, Third, Merit or Honorable Mention) in a prior SCC EXPO then you <u>cannot</u> enter in the Beginners category, but must enter in one of the categories below.	BE
<b>Landscape/Waterscape:</b> Prints that are scenic in nature. They may include manmade objects such as fences, barns, boats, or lighthouses, but these should enhance the image and not be the main subject.	LC
<b>Architecture/Cityscape</b> : Buildings, city skylines, bridges, piers, where the building(s) or structure(s) are the main subject of the image.	сс
Flora: Flowers, plants, and fungi.	FC
<b>Fauna</b> : Animals, insects, reptiles; does not include domestic animals. (Domestic animals should be entered in the General/Open category.)	AC
Ornithology: Birds, Birds, Birds, Only Birds. Photos of birds should not be entered into Fauna.	ос
People: Street photography, portraits, group photos, etc.	PC
Still Life: Photos of arranged objects in a controlled setting.	SL
Photographic Art: Images which use compositing, have extensive post processing manipulation and/or display a change in natural color, form, shape or any combination of these three to create an 'altered reality'. Extensive post processing and compositing would include adding objects, textures and/or filters to the photo. All images must be original and may not incorporate elements produced by anyone else. Images may not be constructed entirely within a computer and may not use elements produced by anyone other than the entrant, with the exception of artwork or computer graphics if the original photographic content predominates. Note: HDR is not considered Photographic Art.	PA
<b>Monochrome:</b> Uses a single color and white. It does not have to be black and white, but it does have to be limited to <u>one color</u> and white.	МС

<sup>\*</sup>Note: Prints may be moved to a category other than the one entered if it is deemed more appropriate by SCC at Check In. Categories may also be combined or eliminated depending on the numbers submitted in each category.

<sup>\*</sup>Post Processing Manipulation: Photos that are entered into any category above (with the exception of Junior, Beginner or Photographic Art) may not have extensive post processing manipulation which may be obvious to the average viewer. Basic processing such as changes in exposure, clarity, vibrance, saturation, sharpness, removal of distracting items, etc. including HDR is acceptable.
